Job Title: School Achiever Leadership Coach

Locations: School Achievers at selected sites (Knapp, Julian Thomas, Mitchell and Wadewitz)

Supervisor: School Achiever Site Coordinators

Wage: \$7.25-\$8.50/hour, up to 20 hours per week

Function

The School Achiever program is primarily designed to provide its inner-city, minority youth between the ages of 7 -10 (2nd – 5th grade) a chance to strengthen and nurture their academic skills. The purpose of the School Achievers program is to nurture the development of leadership abilities and life skills of inner-city, minority youth, empowering them to improve the quality of their life and assist them in becoming productive citizens. The Leadership Coaches provide homework assistance, mentoring and assist Site Coordinators in facilitating group leadership sessions.

This is a seasonal part-time, non-exempt position.

Job Segments

- Provides homework assistance and monitoring in the YLA
- Checks weekly progress reports
- · Prepares afternoon snacks for members
